

THE PROJECT

Extent Heritage was engaged by the City of Moreland to assess the heritage significance of 620 places nominated for statutory protection by members of the public. Our role was to assess whether or not those places met the threshold for listing as places of local heritage significance. Extent also updated the City of Moreland's Thematic History (2010) through review, gap analysis and augmentation.

OUR ROLE

Extent Heritage undertook an intensive program of fieldwork and desktop research. Utilising the findings of surveys, historical research and community consultation, we drew on Burra Charter principles to compile a series of heritage citations for the 620 nominated places. Our additional research also permitted us to update the thematic history that has underpinned assessments in the local government area since 2010.

VALUE UNLOCKED

The project has provided the City of Moreland, property owners and developers in the local government area with clear conservation direction and parameters for future development. Importantly, the local heritage list has been expanded to include previously unrecognised heritage places, including modern late-twentieth century buildings.
