

SUNSHINE SILOS HERITAGE ASSESSMENT

THE PROJECT

The inner-western suburb of Sunshine boasts a rich and diverse working class history that is readily evident in its impressive industrial sites. Extent Heritage was engaged by Brimbank City Council to undertake a heritage assessment of one of these sites – the Sunshine Silos. This included an evaluation of the place against the HERCON criteria to determine if it met the threshold for local heritage listing, and protection through amendment to the local planning scheme.
